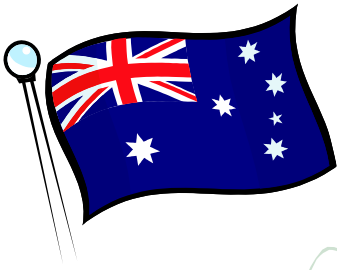
2012 is just around the corner so it's time to start preparing for the new year.
